Eighth Grade Parent night is planned for February 15th in the High School Media Center. Parents will learn about graduation requirements and Career Technical Education Programs.

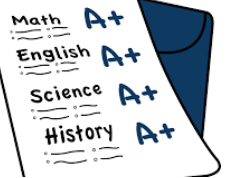
